CANAL CENTRE – Opening Dates and Times

Weekends: Saturdays and Sundays from 15th April 2017 till 24th September.

Tearoom: 1:00pm till 4.30pm (last orders at 4:15pm). **Canal Museum:** 1:00pm till 4.30 pm. Admission FREE.

Weekdays: 3 July till 18 August (Town Cruises, Museum and Tearoom only)

Tearoom and Canal Museum: 2 to 4 pm.

PUBLIC BOAT TRIPS

- Aqueduct Cruises: Return trip to the Avon Aqueduct on board Saint Magdalene. Trip departs at 2.00 pm on Saturdays and Sundays and returns at 4.30 pm. Prices: Adult £8, Concessions £7 and Children £5. Maximum of 40 passengers no booking (first come, first served).
- **Town Cruises:** Short 25 minute cruise on Victoria an open boat. Depart approximately every half hour from 2:00 pm until 4:30 pm. Prices: Adult £4, Concessions £3 and Children £3. Maximum of 12 passengers **no booking** (first come, first served).
- Falkirk Wheel Cruises (booking essential): A half day outing to the world-famous Falkirk Wheel. You have the option to Cruise there, enjoy the Falkirk Wheel and then return to Linlithgow by coach, or *vice versa*. Dates for 2017 are Sunday 28th May, Sunday 25th June, Sunday 30th July and Sunday 27th August. Depart at 9:30 am or 12:30 pm. £22 per person (no concessions). Booking is essential.

SPECIAL EVENTS

Canal Fun Day: A great day out, with something for everyone – boat trips, stalls, amusements and featuring the famous cardboard boat race. Sunday 20th August from 1.00 pm Linlithgow Folk Festival: Evening boat trip Friday 8th September (tbc). Christmas Events:

- Santa arrives at Linlithgow Canal Centre offering presents and a boat trip on Saturday and Sunday 9th and 10th December and Saturday and Sunday 16th and 17th December from 2pm till 4pm.
- Christmas Lunch Cruises on Sunday 10th and Sunday 17th December. Booking is essential.

BOAT HIRE: Advance Booking is Essential (see below).

- Saint Magdalene (with crew): Maximum capacity 40 passengers (36 if the catering table is required). First hour £110, then £55 per additional hour (Minimum hire is 1 hour). Tea/coffee & biscuits £2 per person, if required. Aqueduct Charter (2.5 hours) £185. Taxi to Park Bistro £130. Taxi to Bridge 49 Bistro £185. Charter to Falkirk Wheel £420.
- **Victoria** (with crew): An open boat with a maximum capacity of 12 passengers. First hour £55, then £28 per hour. Minimum hire: 1 hour.
- **Leamington:** A self-drive boat suitable for up to 12 people. Half day (4 hours) £80, Full day £150. Falkirk Wheel hire £180
- **School Parties**: A 30 minute trip and 30 minute canal presentation in Mel Gray Centre: £2 per pupil.

ROOM HIRE

Tearoom: £12 per hour plus £10 per event if the kitchen is also required.

Mel Gray Education Centre: A classroom with toilet and other facilities, available for educational use, meetings and other functions at £12 per hour hire.
