



Covid—19

Essential Information for visitors



Please do not visit our canal basin if you, or anyone you live with, starts displaying cold or flu symptoms including a high temperature, a new continuous cough or loss of, or change in, you normal sense of taste of smell.



LUCS is pleased to welcome visitors back to the canal basin. We wish to offer visitors an enjoyable experience but, for now, to ensure the safety and wellbeing of our visitors and volunteers, we have introduced a range of additional Covid-19 safety measures in line with Scottish Government requirements.

We ask that all visitors take time to read the information in this leaflet before entering the canal basin to protect themselves and our volunteers.

"Bubbles" - in this booklet means those who are allowed to meet indoors in accordance with applicable Scottish Government guidelines.

At the Canal Basin

- Please queue in the marked areas
- Record your visit in accordance with Test and Protect guidance as shown on the back of this leaflet.
- LUCS is only accepting cashless payment: please speak to our volunteers if this is a problem
- Please follow the guidance of LUCS volunteers
- Maintain 2-metres physical distancing outside. Inside the Tearoom and on boats, social distancing is 1-metre and masks must be worn
- Use hand sanitiser at the locations provided
- Toilets are available in the yard beyond the tearoom, these are regularly cleaned

Museum

- Do not do so if anyone else is inside, wait for them to leave
- Only one bubble at a time is allowed in the Museum
- Remove and replace the chain at the entrance on entry and departure
- · Wear a face covering

Electric Boats

 Regrettably we are unable to offer electric boat hire whilst Covid-19 restrictions are in force

Tearoom

- Queue for the tearoom in your bubbles two metres apart in the marked areas. Within the tearoom, one bubble is allowed at the counter and one at the entrance door.
- Maintain one- metre social distancing and wear a face-covering, except when seated at tables
- Place your order at the counter and collect it at the hatchway
- Only one person, or a bubble may sit at a table
- Follow the one-way system and exit the tea room through the doubledoors at the far end

Aqueduct Trips

- Tickets should be booked in advance at https://www.lucs.org.uk/boat-trips/aqueduct-cruises
 These are sold by tables for individuals or bubbles
- One-metre social distancing and mask wearing is required at all times whilst on board
- Unfortunately, LUCS is unable to offer catering whilst Covid-19 restrictions are in force. Do not consume your own food and drink on board
- When arriving at the basin, please board the boat as soon as possible after your arrival.
- Due to Covid restrictions, LUCS is currently unable to offer boarding assistance for mobility impaired passengers. If such assistance is required passengers are requested to ask someone in their bubble.
- To ensure ventilation the windows and front door on the boat will be open. If it is a cold day please dress accordingly

Town Trips

- Town trips take about 20 minutes and run every 30 minutes
- Only two bubbles are allowed on each trip—one bubble to each bench
- Masks must be worn at all times whilst on board.
